## From the Pastor's Desk:

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

When I was assigned by Bishop Robert Brom as pastor for the very first time in 2007, I had just been ordained a priest for one and a half years. It is Jesus Christ, the Good Shepherd, who always has been and always will be in charge.
