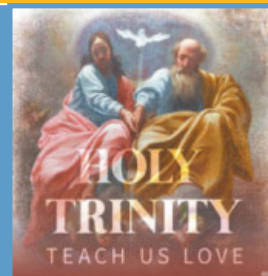

On this Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, we are reminded to encourage one another, and to show affection and support.



This Sunday is Trinity Sunday
