GOSPEL MEDITATION

Do you ever feel restless? I certainly do. Daily tasks and challenges, but also the more basic demand of simply existing—sooner or later, this can all feel crushing and tire us out.

Which is why Jesus' words are such stunningly good news: "Come to me all you who labor and are burdened and I will give you rest" (Matthew 11:28). How vastly weird that this man speaks as though he is capable of giving us the deep repose we desire. Is his claim the height of absurd grandiosity? No, because next he immediately proclaims that he is meek and humble of heart." We here touch a mistery: Jesus is capable of giving us rest because he is the one who forever reposes in the heart of God the Father. He is yoked to us, sharing in our humanity.

The good news, my fellow tired-out friends, we don't have to despair in our burdens and exhaustion, no matter how heavy they feel. This week, join me in opening our hearts to hear him say to us. "Come! I will give you rest." We come to him in the church, Eucharist. The Scriptures, prayer, in the poor. There he will give us rest. —*Fr. John Muir*



Outdoor Classroom Learning!

Student campers enjoyed learning about the herbs, native plants and succulents in the school courtyard planters. Some fun and educational varieties of succulents include: Pig's Ear (Cotyledon orbiculata), Propeller Plant (Crassula falcata), Flapjack Paddle Plant (Kalanchoe), Zebra Plant (Haworthia fasciat), Miniature Pine Tree (Crassula tetragona), Blue Chalk Sticks (Senecio serpens), Aloe Vera and Fox Tail Agaves.

After all the pruning, campers took home a bag of Rosemary and a variety of succulents to grow at home.



<u>Five year old</u> artichoke plants in the garden produced almost 50 artichokes this year. Summer campers took home artichokes, a lemon and recipe to try this vegetable at home. Many had never seen or tasted an artichoke before. With a follow up survey, the students and their families loved them!
