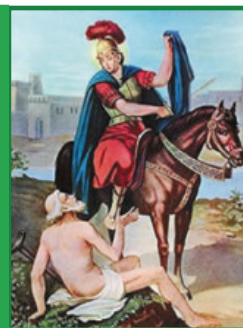

THE YEAR OF EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL

Different forms of Penitential Acts

Now that we've gone over the purpose of the penitential act, and differentiated it from Sacramental Confession (which must be done before receiving the Eucharist if one is in the state of mortal sin), we can now look at the different forms of Penitential Act. There are three forms of the Penitential Act. There are two that can be found on the gray mass supplement in your pew. Please take a look at it if you're able to.

Form A is the Confiteor, in which we all say, "I Confess to Almighty God and to you my brothers and sisters..." When said prayerfully, these words fully express the sorrow of our faults in words and action. We even strike our breast as a gesture of humility and sorrow for sins. Form B is less practiced but one we should still know. The presider prays, "Have mercy on us, O Lord," and the people respond, "For we have sinned against you." The presider continues, "Show us O Lord, your mercy," and the people again respond, "And grant us your salvation." For Form C, a brief statement is made about Jesus and then we have the repetition of the phrase, "Lord Have Mercy... Christ Have Mercy... Lord Have Mercy..." These phrases remind us who Jesus is and what he does for us, and how we call for his mercy.

After each form, "the *Kyrie Eleison* (Lord, have mercy), is always begun unless it has already been part of the penitential Act" (GIRM, no. 52).

Understanding and receiving God's mercy, we then move to give glory to God in the next part: The Gloria.

FIELD TRIPS AT SMA!

Field trips have begun and students are excited to experience new ways to learn outside the classroom. Fourth and fifth grade students participated in an overnight adventure on the Star of India. Students simulating to be sailing from Great Britain to the west coast of the United States through New Zealand. Students relive the lives of 1870's emigrants who have signed aboard as sailors "before the mast" in exchange for passage. Through role-playing and cooperative learning techniques, students were immersed intellectually, physically and emotionally in shipboard activities. 
