THE YEAR OF EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL

The Four Gospels

In the previous article, we mentioned the fourfold Gospel, which is the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John. But why is it that we have four separate accounts? Why don't we just put them altogether?

One can see these differences as a hindrance, thinking that Christians can't get their story straight. But after many years of preaching and meditation, the Gospel writers took what they heard through the oral teachings and wrote them down so their audience can more easily understand Jesus as Christ, Messiah, and Lord.

Matthew, Mark and Luke are very similar in view. For this, we call them the "synoptic" Gospels, meaning one view. They are very similar in content while they may still have details that are not in others and with events not in the same order. John is written completely different.

For a brief overview, this is the differences one can find. (1) Matthew wrote towards a Jewish audience, not explaining rituals and showing how Jesus was the true Messiah. (2) Luke was writing for a Greek audience, who needed more detailed explanations. (3) Mark provides a narrative in great detail to show Jesus is the Son of God. John provides other miracles and teachings confirm reader's faith in Jesus, as many may have been familiar from the other stories mentioned in the last three.

In having all Four Gospels written close to the time of Jesus, we can understand who He is and what He does for us. Jesus, the Son of God, the Messiah, the Christ, the Savior of the World!
