



#### **Eucharistic Revival: Altar Setup**

Hopefully as music is played and being sung, one can meditate on the beauty of the mystery that is about to happen right in front of us, which is, as Fr. Luke Spannagel puts it, "Jesus Christ's one perfect sacrifice before the Father is made present to his spouse, the Church, and the bread and the wine are changed into the Body and Blood of Christ."

But of course for that to happen, the main two things we need of course are unleavened bread and grape wine. And even before that, one may notice many things put on or by the altar. Things that one should notice are the candles, crucifix, missal, corporal, chalice, paten, purificator, paten, and ciborium.


Have you ever thought of everything that is put on the altar? In the next couple of articles, we will go in depth on these materials that are needed for the Liturgy of the Eucharist.


