

THE YEAR OF EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL

Altar Set up

What are some things that one may notice are put
on the altar as we prepare for the Liturgy of the Eucharist here
at St. Martin of Tours and all Catholic Churches?

The first thing that one may notice is the **Roman
Missal**. This book contains the prayers of the Mass and the
rubrics for how a Mass is to be said. If one were to take a look
into a Missal, one would see there are words in black and red
ink. The words in black show which words the priest says and
words in red are instructions for the priest on what to do.

The next couple of items are usually brought up
together. These would be the **Chalice, Corporal, Purificator,
Paten, and Ciborium, and Pall**.

The **Chalice** is the special cup made out of precious
metal which will be used to honor Jesus who is truly made
present there in his most precious Body and Blood. The
Corporal is a square white cloth placed on the altar. The
meaning of the word comes from the word meaning body. On
this cloth the Body and Blood of Christ is made present and is
there to make sure no fragment of the Eucharist is lost. The
Paten is a small plate that is also gold-plated or silver plated
which is used for the large host which the priest holds up
during the Eucharistic Prayer. One may also notice the
Ciborium which contains the smaller hosts used to distribute
the Body of Christ and also are containers to hold the Eucharist
in the tabernacle.

The **purificator** is the white cloth that is used to
wipe the rim and the inside of the chalice. Lastly, the pall is the
square white cloth stiffened with cardboard that is used to
cover the chalice. This is to help prevent dust or insects from
getting into the chalice.

At the next mass that you attend, I hope you are able to see
the significance of these articles used in the mass.

ASH WEDNESDAY**February 14th is Ash Wednesday.**

This is not a Holy Day of Obligation, however,
it is a day of fast and abstinence.

Masses and Distribution of Ashes will be:
8:30am 12:00pm & 6:00pm

FAST & ABSTINENCE

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from ages 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the physically or mentally ill, including individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes. Also excluded are pregnant or nursing women. In all cases, common sense should prevail, and ill persons should not further jeopardize their health by fasting.


THE LITTLE BLACK PRAYER BOOKS FOR LENT


