

**The gifts and words of Thanksgiving**

After the gifts are brought up and as the offertory song continues to play, one might notice that the priest holds up the paten and chalice one at a time as he says words of prayer. If you go to daily mass, you may have heard the words.

The priest says, "Blessed are you, Lord God of all creation, for through your goodness we have received the bread we offer you: fruit of the earth and work of human hands, it will become for us the bread of life." And if there is no song sung, the congregation replies, "Blessed be God Forever." The priest says a similar prayer while lifting the chalice.

These words allow us to remember that as we bring such gifts as "coming from the work of human hands," this unleavened bread and wine, they are ultimately a gift of God. For it is through these gifts that will become our Eucharistic meal, the Body and Blood of Christ. These gifts will become the bread of life and our spiritual drink. During this time of the mass, in your silent prayer I hope you come to truly appreciate these gifts set in front of us, and all the gifts that we may give in offering, as we give to God what he has given us.
