

Washing of Hands

After a small break from our tour of the Mass series, we are now back! A couple of weeks ago we focused on the first silent prayers the priest says during the offertory and the incense. Now we continue with the part where the priest washes his hands.

The dish that the priest uses is called a *lavabo* (meaning, "I shall wash) and dries them with a towel. The practical means of doing this is to wash his hands after the priest has touched all the offertory vessels and the censor (if he uses incense). This is also an act to express a desire for inward purification before taking up the bread which is about to become the body of Christ.

Although the offerings are clean as presented today, in the early days people would bring more things up for the offertory that were more than just containers of bread and wine. For such things that weren't as clean, of course the priest would want to wash his hands before continuing on to the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.

As the priest washes his hands, the private prayer he says is, "Wash me, O Lord, from my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin." I knowing such words, I hope you unite yourself more fully to the mass and call the Lord to cleanse you from your sins.



**Effective July 1st, Fr. Ignatius Kipchirchir will be our New Pastor,**



Fr. Ignatius was born and raised in Nandi County, Kenya, known for long distance runners. He is the second of six boys. He got interested in vocation to the priesthood during his elementary school, run by nuns, as well as great influence from his Irish Pastor, when he was an altar server. He joined High School Seminary and later proceeded to Senior Seminary for his priestly formation. He got his BA in Philosophy and religious studies from Catholic University of Eastern Africa and his BA in Theology from Saint Mathias Mulumba Seminary. He was ordained as Transitional Deacon on January 6th, 2009, and ordained as a Priest on November 7th, 2009. He served two parishes in Kenya (3.5 years) before proceeding for graduate studies at University of San Diego. He graduated with an MA in Peace and Justice in 2014.

Fr. Ignatius was assigned to Our Lady of Mount Carmel, San Diego in September 2014 to August 2017, to Saint Jude Shrine of the West and Saint Anthony in National City from August 2017 to July 2018. He was assigned back to Our Lady of Mount Carmel, as Associate Pastor in July 2018 where he has been serving up to date. Aside from his priestly duties, Fr. Ignatius loves running and playing basketball.



## Planning for a Catholic Funeral...



By virtue of one's baptism, a Catholic is eligible for the funeral rites of the Church. While the Church recommends that the pious custom of burying the bodies of the dead be observed, cremation is permitted as long as it is in line with Catholic teaching.

The cremains should be treated with the same respect given to the body of the deceased and should be entombed or buried. The scattering of cremains on the ground or at sea, or keeping any portion of them for personal reasons is not the reverent final disposition that the Church directs.
