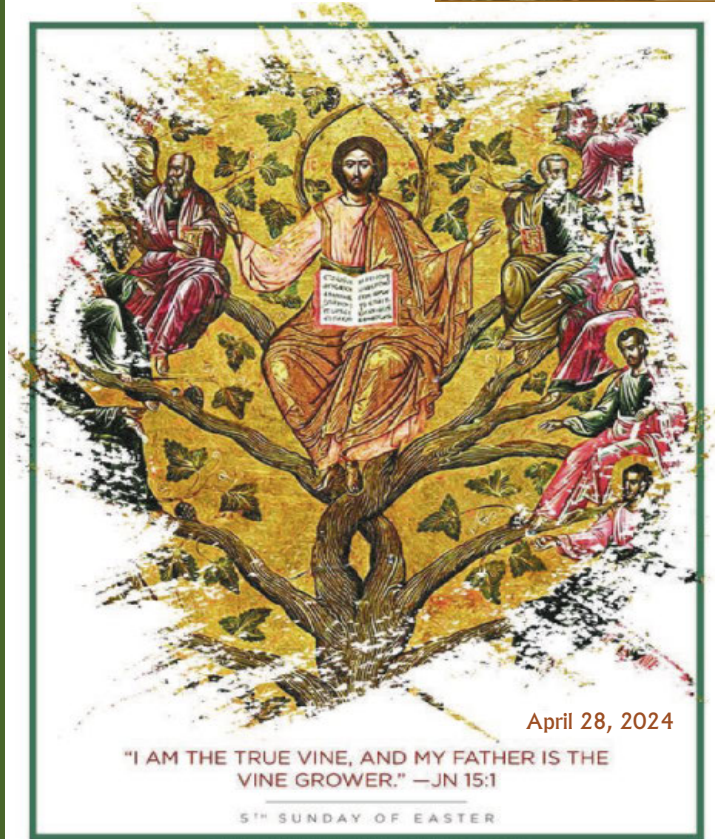

**Prayer over the offerings**

The next small part that often gets overlooked is the prayer over the offerings. This prayer points us towards the upcoming Eucharistic prayer. If one pays attention to this part, one may notice key words such as: prayers, gifts, sacrifices, oblations. In true sincerity, the people along with the priest ask God to accept these gifts, this sacrifice, this oblation that we make to Him.

As one can see, these are words of transition that are leading us towards the climax of the mass. The prayers for this Sunday is this: "O God, who by the wonderful exchange effected in this sacrifice have made us partakers of the one supreme Godhead, grant, we pray, that, as we have come to know your truth, we may make it ours by a worthy way of life. Through Christ our Lord."

In this sacrifice we partake in the gifts God wants for us. That as we continue to live our lives we come to know the truth of our faith and to always be like God. I am not saying we are becoming God, but that we - in our journey of God - are supposed to be growing closer in union with our God and His will. Through the sacrifice Jesus makes, we are called and given the grace to lead a life of Holiness. How amazing is that?
