### THE YEAR OF EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL

#### The Eucharistic Prayer

Now we have reached my favorite part! And I hope it is your favorite part, or if not, I hope it will be yours very soon. During this time is the **Eucharistic Prayer**, the high point of the mass in which we all lift our prayer in thanksgiving and sanctification. The prayer is led by the priest, but it is important for all the faithful to be attuned to the words that are said, and most importantly the bread and wine which will become the Body and Blood of Christ. The true presence of Jesus will soon be right in front of us. But maybe to appreciate the prayer being said, We have to break it down. The main elements of the Eucharistic Prayer are as follows:

(1)The Thanksgiving, (2), The acclamation,(3) The epiclesis (4) The institution narrative and Consecration (5) Anamnesis (6) Oblation, (7) The Intercessions (8) The Doxology

For all these words and prayers being said at this part, who knew each part had a name? One may notice there are different options for Eucharistic Prayers, some shorter and some longer. Yet all Eucharistic Prayers have these elements in mind. In the following weeks let's dive into each of these parts so we can have a greater appreciation for the Mass.






A special marriage formation program designed for couples entering remarriage after one or both partners has experienced loss through death or
