

THE YEAR OF EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL

Preface: The Dialogue

As we enter into the Eucharistic prayer, let us remind ourselves what Eucharist means: Thanksgiving. Ultimately the eucharistic prayer is a prayer of thanksgiving and sanctification.

The priest, acting in the person of Christ offers this prayer with the whole community to give adoration and praise. We have a prayer of thanksgiving especially in what is called the **Preface**.

The beginning of the Preface should be familiar. It start out with a dialogue:

The Lord be with you. And with your spirit. Lift up your hearts. We lift them up to the Lord Let us give **thanks** to the Lord our God. It is right and just.

This dialogue has been a part of the mass at least since 215 AD when it was first reported. In saying this dialogue, we continue to unite with Christians throughout the ages.


The first part of the prayer we have already explained before. But how about this part where it says, "Lift up your hearts"? This should be a wakeup call! We are called to give our full attention right now! To what? To give proper thanks to our God! Because it is right and just to always do so. Next time you say this dialogue, say it with your full heart.




