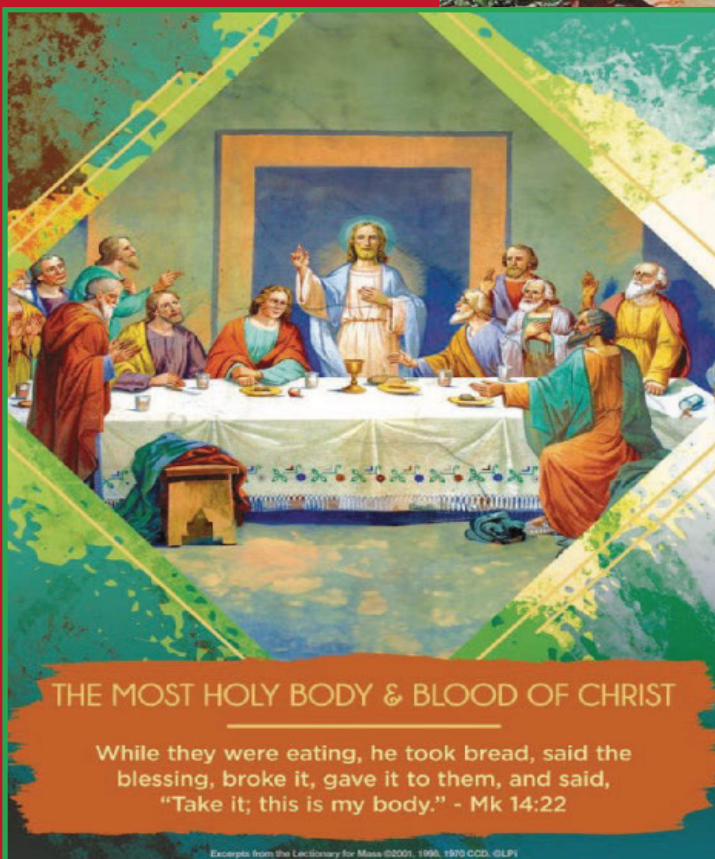

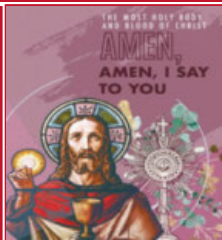

Sanctus

The last couple of weeks we looked at the Preface. After saying significant truths of the faith, we are called to sing in adoration along with the choirs of angels who endlessly sing a song of praise. In the Liturgy we are given a small foretaste of what it must be like in the Heavenly Liturgy. So in such a moment, we join our prayer and chant in true praise and Worship by singing the *Sanctus* or you may know it as the "Holy, Holy Holy".

Why do we praise God in such a way? This song of praise stitches a few verses together. We find that when the Prophet Isaiah saw a vision of the Lord on a throne with angels singing, they sung, "Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord of hosts!" (Isaiah 6:3) One should also know saying a word in this was also a way to emphasize it is a superlative, meaning when we say Holy three times, we are saying the Lord is the most Holy.

Later on in Revelation, in knowing St. John's vision of heaven, he describes four living creatures continuously exclaiming, "Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord God almighty, who was and who is, and who is to come".

The second part of the Sanctus we may remember hearing on Palm Sunday as we recall Jesus' entry into Jerusalem. "Hosanna to the Son of David; blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest" (Mt. 21:9).

Next week we'll break down all the parts of the *Sanctus* and see how this moment calls us to full joy and praise. This joy should carry us towards our most joyful moment, which is Jesus truly and substantially present on the altar.

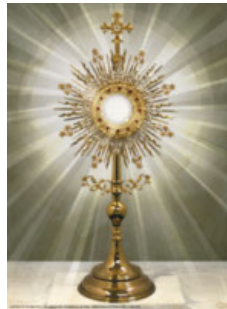

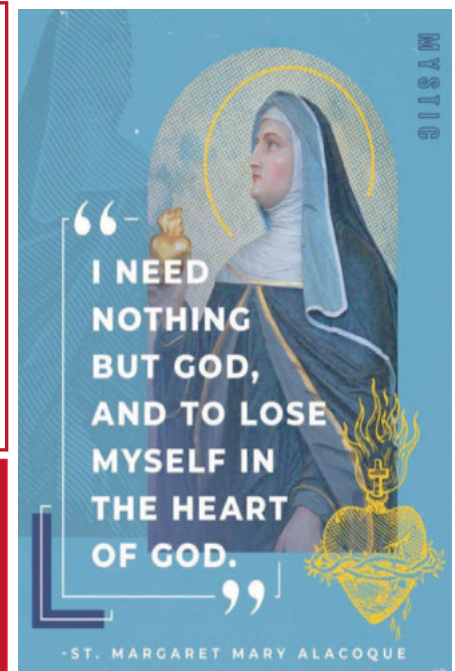
