

Eucharistic Prayer Options

After the Sanctus, the faithful find themselves in a kneeling position. Why? Because in a few moments the memorial action of the covenant, Jesus institutes, will be made right in front of us. And Jesus will be truly present.

As we kneel, we may notice the differing prayers. On weekends you may notice what I usually use, which is Eucharistic Prayer III. On Weekdays I usually use Eucharistic Prayer II. And on great solemnities, one might notice, I use Eucharistic Prayer I. Even though I use these three the most, there are actually ten Eucharistic Prayers to choose from. The first four are the most common.

The Missal (the book that contains the prayers during the mass) also contains two Eucharistic Prayers for Reconciliation and four prayers for Masses of Various Needs. The title for these options are the following: "The Church on the Path of Unity"; "God Guides His Church along the Way of Salvation"; "Jesus, the Way to the Father"; and "Jesus, Who Went About Doing Good." There is instructions on when these prayers may be more appropriate to say.

I invite you to familiarize yourself with such prayers so you can understand what is being said. We will be going through the different parts in the upcoming weeks, but you may find the prayers accessible to read by picking up a Sunday Missal or Daily Roman Missal for yourself.






Youth Group leadership team. This helped me discover my passion for working with children of all ages and find myself as I continue to expand my horizons in life.
