#### Eucharistic Prayer Background

As a reminder, although there are different Eucharistic prayers that may have different emphases, the main parts include the epiclesis, the institution narrative and Consecration, anamnesis, oblation, intercessions, and concluding doxology. But before we get into these "five dollar words," let's seek out what the Eucharistic Prayer is meant to express.

In our reading from scripture, one knows that Jesus "gave thanks" (1 Cor. 11:24; Lk 22:17) and "said a blessing" (Mt. 26:26; Mk 14:22) as they entered into the ritual meal of the Passover. In such a setting one should not be surprised that the Eucharistic prayer has its roots in Jewish prayers said at every meal. In such a meal, there was a prayer of blessing (barakah) as they took bread, saying "Blessed are you, Lord, our God, king of the universe, who has brought forth bread from heaven." Then there would be a longer prayer over a cup of wine when the meal was nearing the end. The prayer included (1) praise of God for his creation, (2) thanksgiving for his redemptive work in the past, and (3) supplication for the future. That sounds a little familiar doesn't it?

But the difference in such a pattern happens in His Institution of the Eucharist. In the Last Supper, He leaves us a memorial of his covenant. To not only recall the freeing of the Israelites from Egypt. But for us to recall our salvation and redemption with Christ away from sin. During the Eucharistic prayer, hear these simple parts prayed, and then we'll dive into the specific parts later.
