

Consecration

Finally we have made it! We now have made it to the **consecration**. Through the priest who is acting in *persona Christi* (In the person of Christ), we are guided to hear the words of Jesus and be present in front of Him:

"Take this, all of you, and eat of it, for this is my Body, which will be given up for you." And then, "Take this, all of you, and drink from it, for this is the chalice of my Blood, the Blood of the new and eternal covenant, which will be poured out for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins. Do this in memory of me."

Jesus commanded his apostles to continually bring the great mystery of this one sacrifice. In these words, through the apostles, and through the voice and hands of priests throughout the ages, Jesus is made present, Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity.

After all the preparation done before this moment, in bringing ourselves in a prayerful mode, to being nourished by the readings and homily, to getting ourselves ready to be an offering to God through Christ, Jesus is now right in front of us. It should be no wonder that the faithful kneel and stay still as we all share in the sacrifice of Christ. In these moments, may our gaze of the Body and Blood of Christ always bring our hearts to another image we see throughout the mass- the Crucifix. May our attitude in the mass always lead our hearts towards the honor and privilege it is to be truly present in front of Christ. May our gaze towards His sacrifice give us strength to live in Him.


