

THE YEAR OF EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL



Anamnesis

What is said after the words of consecration? After the priest elevates the chalice and genuflects towards it in adoration, he says, "The mystery of faith." There are then three responses we are invited to say: (1) We proclaim your Death, O Lord, and profess your Resurrection until you come again, (2) When we eat this Bread and drink this Cup, we proclaim your Death, O Lord, until you come again, and (3) Save us, Savior of the world, for by your Cross and Resurrection you have set us free.

This is what is called the **Memorial** Acclamation or Anamnesis (Ann-am-NEE-sis). As Jesus is now present on the altar, we make a joyful acclamation of the mystery of faith we are all called to profess. One can even read in 1 Cor. 11:26- "For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes."

In the mass we are called to reflect on what Jesus has done for us in the past, and always bring it forward to each mass and proclaim in the present the great mystery of faith until the day he comes. In the mass, his offering is made present, not just something that he has done in the past, but continues to do. He is our redemption and that is a present reality! Let us say these words fully in the Joy of our salvation through Christ.

Alright, we've gone through all the steps we do before Mass, in reminding of ourselves of our Baptism, in giving reverence to Jesus in the tabernacle, and allowing ourselves to have brief moments of silence to prepare our hearts for the Sacred Mass.

Now we begin the Introductory Rites of the Mass with the Entrance hymn. It is known that St. Augustine said "Singing is for one who loves," and there is also the ancient proverb: "Whoever sings well prays twice over."

We know it takes more effort to sing than it is to speak, so in a special way we are invited in the beginning of the mass to praise God with our very being through singing.

Now, one may say that they are not the best singer, but the Christian people are called to sing together, for what a great image it is to see, not just the cantor or choir or priest singing, but the whole Church. A sign towards our heavenly reality that with the choirs of Angels and Holy Men and Women we uplift our voices and our hearts to Him.

At the Mass do not be afraid to sing, for it shows with one voice that we are a community all getting ready for the ultimate prayer, the Mass.
