

Of course, we pray for all of us in this holy moment. For instance, in Eucharistic Prayer III, we pray that Jesus makes of us an eternal offering to the Father so that we may obtain an inheritance with your elect (the Saints). We also ask the Saints to intercede for us as well.

We pray for the advancement of peace and salvation of all the world. We pray for the Pope, the Head of the Church. We pray for the Order of Bishops and our Local Bishops on whom authority has been delegated to in the Diocese they lead. We pray for all clergy who work as coworkers and helpers of the bishops in the parishes and all their ministries. This part of the prayer shows our union as the faithful, with our Bishop, Pope, and the universal Church.

Lastly, we pray for all of us, his children, and for the faithful departed. With all of our intercessions, I hope we take them to heart, and lift them up in prayer with the whole Church.
