

THE YEAR OF EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL



Eucharistic Revival: All the Saints

On days when Eucharistic Prayer I is used, one might hear a long list of saints that one might not be familiar with. Who are all these people?

Let's tackle the first list. The first two are saints we should all know and love, Mother Mary and St. Joseph. Then the next section is the Apostles and Martyrs: Peter and Paul, Andrew, James, John, Thomas, James, Philip, Bartholomew, Matthew, Simon and Jude. Do we know how they died?

Peter died through crucifixion but he was hung upside down because he did not find himself worth of dying the same death of Jesus. Paul died in a beheading. Peter's brother Andrew, was hung on a cross in an X-shape.

James (the greater) was the first apostle to die and he was executed with a sword. John is typically known to die of old age but we know him to be the beloved disciple. Thomas was impaled by a spear. James (the lesser) was stoned and clubbed to death.

Philip was believed to have been crucified upside down. Bartholomew was skinned alive and beheaded. Matthew died by the sword. Simon was said to be sawn in half and Jude died by an ax. For these Apostles who preached and died for Christ, May our prayer join with theirs to be in communion with God.







Planning for a Catholic Funeral

By virtue of one's baptism, a Catholic is eligible for the funeral rites of the Church. While the Church recommends that the pious custom of burying the bodies of the dead be observed, cremation is permitted as long as it is in line with Catholic teaching.

The cremains should be treated with the same respect given to the body of the deceased and should be entombed or buried. The scattering of cremains on the ground or at sea, or keeping any portion of them for personal reasons is not the reverent final disposition that the Church directs.
