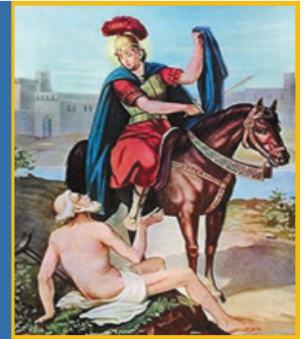

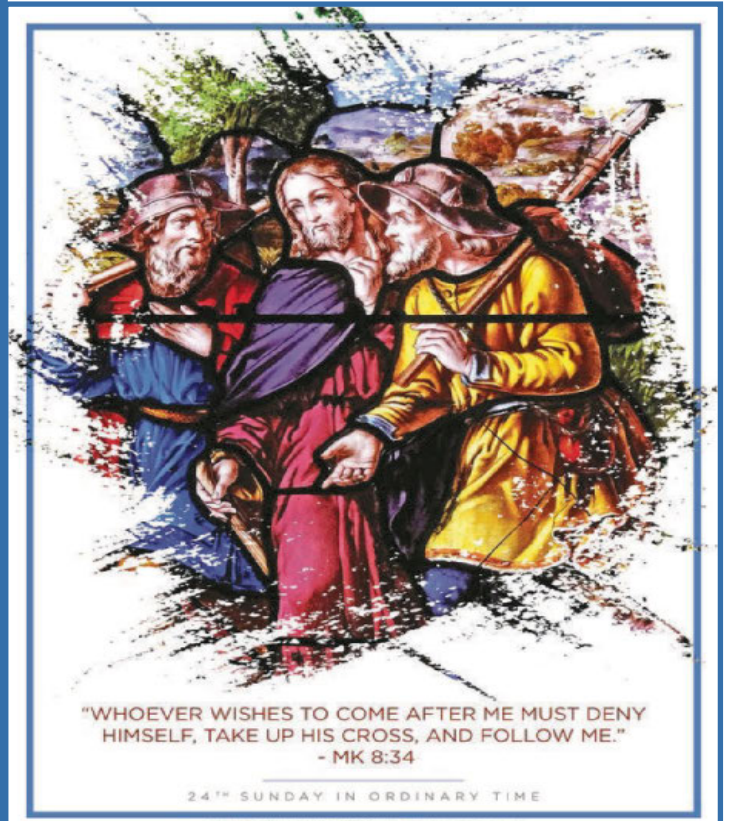

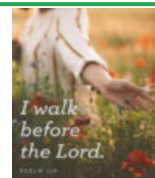

Saint Names Continued

Now that we've gone through the Apostle's names, we continue to early Saints. The first 5 mentioned are Peter's successors. The first three are St. Peter's direct successors: Linus, Cletus, and Clement. Clement is known to be martyred by being tied to an anchor and thrown into the sea.

The last two are from the third century: Sixtus II and Cornelius. Sixtus II was pope from 257 to 258 and was one of the early Church's most venerated martyrs. He was beheaded along with six deacons. Cornelius fought hard against heresy and helped in understanding of what to do when Christians commit apostasy (the abandonment or renunciation of their beliefs) amongst persecution. He died under hardships of exile, but he is still considered by the Church a martyr.

St. Cyprian, Bishop of Carthage, was a great defender of the faith and was beheaded by a sword.

St. Lawrence was a deacon, who was demanded by his prosecutor to bring the "treasures" of the Church. Lawrence brought Him the poor people of the Church. He died a gruesome death on top of an iron grill a couple days after St. Sixtus II's martyrdom.

St. Chrysogonus was a priest who comforted Christians in prison and was eventually martyred. John and Paul, were officers of the imperial palace who were put to death under the emperor at the time. Lastly, Cosmas and Damian were Arabian physicians who embraced the Christian faith. They brought much healing but were martyred because they did not renounce their faith.

In honor of these saints and all saints who have given their life for Christ, let us keep their memory in our hearts so that we can be in Communion with them in Heaven.

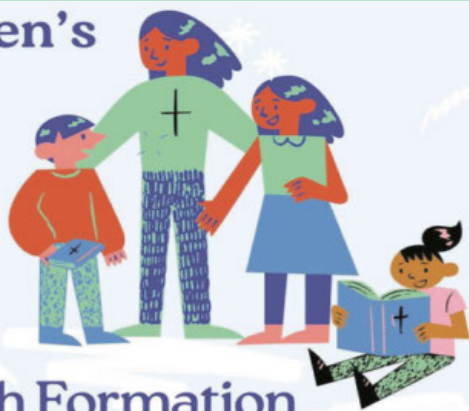

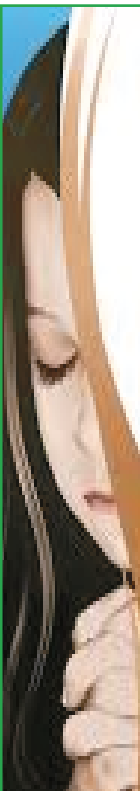

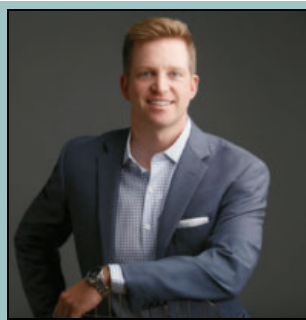
