

Eucharistic Revival: Doxology

Now, we reach the end of the Eucharistic Prayer with special words from the priest which have been called **the Doxology**.

This is a "Christian prayer which gives praise and glory to God, often in a special way to the three divine persons of the Trinity" (CCC, 875.) The Greek word doxa means glory. We may even refer to other prayers as doxologies, such as the "Gloria" we say at the beginning of mass, as it says, "Glory to God in the Highest." This can be known as the "Greater Doxology." The Glory Be prayer that we say in our prayers, "Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now ,and ever shall be world without end," is known as the "Lesser Doxology"

But in the Eucharistic Prayer, You might know this part as the part the priest usually sings, "Through Him, and with Him, and in Him, O God Almighty Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit. All glory and honor is yours, forever and ever."

This is to say, as the priest raises up the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, in the grand sacrifice that Jesus made for us, we give all glory to God. That through Jesus, with Jesus and in Jesus, through His one sacrifice that He made for us, we give God all glory. In this moment we rejoice in bringing our own offerings and attaching it to His sacrifice as we say "Amen."




"Order of Christian Initiation for Adults" **Interested in becoming Catholic** O.C.I.A. is the process by which
